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I have been a resident of Flushing for over 30 years. I have served this community as an activist, a counselor, community leader and Democratic District Leader for over 20 years. I have lead marches against violence and the abuse of women as well as helped hundreds of families in need. I am an independent Democrat who is not beholden to party bosses. This year I am running in the Democratic Primary for a vacant seat in the NYS Assembly for the 40th District in Queens.

There are several issues that I am passionate about but I outlined three in particular below.

A level playing field is vital in our participatory democracy. Currently, in New York State elections for the legislature are lopsided and favor the well funded and connected candidates. New York State should mirror the model established by the City of New York through the Campaign Finance Board which provides matching funds and prohibits corporate donations as well as establishing spending caps. Only then will grass roots campaigns have somewhat equal footing for State legislative offices.

As important as campaign finance is transparency in our government. Corruption should be thoroughly investigated and punished. Legislators should fully disclose all outside income and the exemption for attorneys that is currently in place in New York should be eliminated.

On the issue of the environment I am against fracking as it poses dangers to the environment. Our State needs to make a real effort in promoting Green energy. We should reduce the amount of vehicles on our roads through smart policies such as investing and expanding mass transit. We should also mandate by statute higher mpg in New York State. Finally, all non emergency state vehicles should be hybrids as well as all public transportation in the state including cabs.
