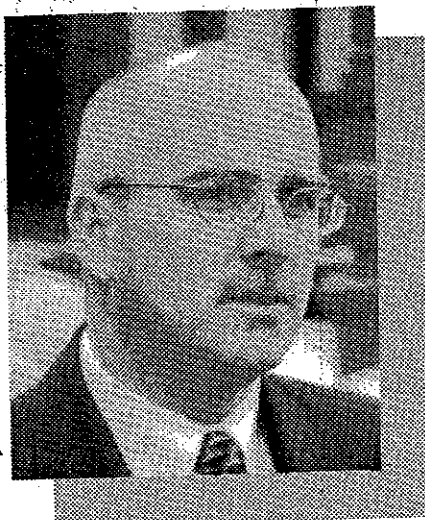

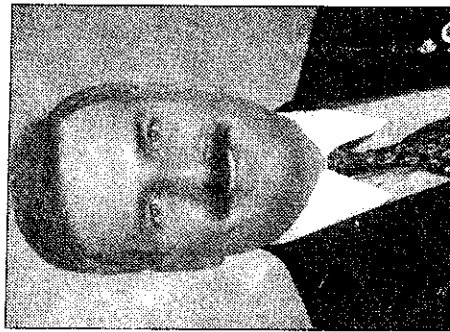

Richmond Hill Republican Club In Desperate Need Of Repair

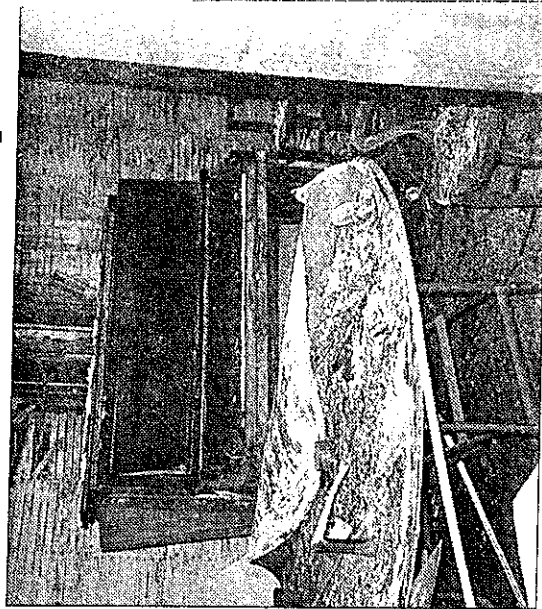

Nearly three years after the city's Landmarks Preservation Commission designated it a landmark, the 97-year-old Richmond Hill Republican Club remains a crumbling, graffiti-covered eyesore.

The floors in the building, located at 86-15 Lefters Boulevard, are caving in from water damage, the windows are broken and trash left by vagrants is strewn all over. Most of the furniture has been stolen by vandals, who most recently broke into the building on July 4th. What remains is decaying.

"The problem is ownership," said Nancy Cataldi, president of the Richmond Hill Historical Society. When the club was founded, its members bought shares of the building. Over the years, as they died off and left them to heirs, it became increasingly difficult to sort out who was an actual shareholder.

Cataldi's organization has been able to locate a few remaining shareholders, but they do not have the money to pay for the repairs, which are estimated to cost \$800,000. There is a tax lien on the building, which has grown to an amount in excess of \$300,000 and the property is now being held by IF Roberts Company.

But Cataldi has her doubts, as does Mary Ann Carey, district manager of Community Board 9. They question whether Casper really is a shareholder as well as his true intentions for the building.

"I think he is looking to make a quick buck," Carey said. She noted that he came forward after Richmond Hill community members as well as then-Borough President Claire Schulman and State Senator Serphin Mafese were starting to come up with ideas for paying for the repairs.

Cataldi remains skeptical. "He's claiming he has shares but there's nothing there."
